Description

The workshop will combine lectures, case study discussion and practical stations. The lectures will include, the science behind the treatment, guidance on appropriate patient selection, procedure planning and treatment under local anaesthetic.

There will be rotational practical stations with hands-on. The practical sessions will use both models and simulators. The stations will include intrauterine ultrasound image interpretation and procedure demonstration.

Stations will also include discussion on defining appropriate patient selection and discussing best practice local anaesthetic protocols. The case studies will include videos and intrauterine images including hearing from the patients on their first hand experiences following their treatments.
